Rules

- Tournament will begin on Tuesday, June 7 at 12:01 am and end on Thursday, June 9 at 7 pm and registration can be in person at Indian Beach Resort or by phone with one of the tournament committee members (see below), beginning Monday, June 6 after 12 pm.
- Members of CA Northwest COGIC jurisdiction are eligible for cash and trophy prizes – non-jurisdictional participants receive trophies only
- **Before fishing**, each participant must be registered for the tournament. Fish caught prior to registration will not be considered.
- Pastors who wish to be considered for the "most members present" recognition, must have all their members registered.
- Only fish which meet Fish and Game requirements will be weighed (bass must be 12", catfish = no size requirement)
- Weigh-ins will be conducted daily—consult a Tournament Committee member for time and place
- All fish will be marked at the weigh-in
- All participants must bring in their own fish to be weighed
- No fish pooling (remember: fellowship and fun – catch your own fish)
- A person cannot win two prizes in any one category
- All questions & issues will be referred to the Tournament Committee for resolution

In the event of a tie . . .

- **Largest fish**
 - 1st consideration will be weight
 - 2nd consideration will be length
 - 3rd consideration will be girth
- **Most fish**
 - 1st consideration is the number of fish
 - 2nd consideration is weight

In the unlikely event that there is no winner in a category, the prize will roll over to the next year.
